Studio Four's tip of the week

Contouring

What is it?...

Contouring is the clever use of shades & highlights, using blusher to create the perfect oval shape face.

Rule of Contouring...

Anything light accentuates, anything dark recedes.

Example of Contouring...

A single way to create high cheekbones is to put your lips together to blow a kiss; the hollow that appears under your cheekbone is where the darker blusher is applied, such as "Mac Harmony". Apply the lighter shade across the apple of the cheek, such as "Mac Strada".

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What colour eye shadow will suit my eyes ?



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As professional make-up artists this is one of the most frequent questions we are asked, so here are some tips to help you figure out what shades would best suit your eye colour.

Green eyes:

Shades of salmon, mauve, pink and brownish pink really make green eyes look greener and more striking.

Brown eyes:

Slate blue, grey and plum will make Brown eyes stand out.

Blue eyes:

Shades of brown, gold & taupe will ensure blue eyes appear even bluer.

Enhancing Eyes with Shading

To bring eyes closer...

Place a darker colour on the eyelids at the inner corners.

To make deep set eyes stand out...

Lighten the socket line.

To 'lift' the outside of the eye...

Shade the outside of eye corner towards the brow blending away to nothing.
