will travel. She caters for one on one lessons and also teaches professional courses.

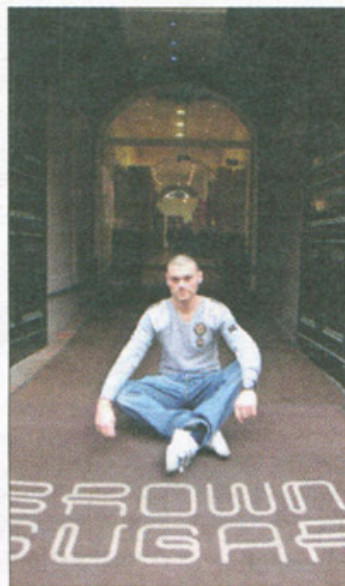
